



GENERAL INFORMATION

SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS is the second-largest city in the state of Texas and the 7th largest city in the United States with a population of 1.3 million. Famous for Spanish missions, the Alamo, The River Walk, The Tower of Americas, the Alamo Bowl, and host to SeaWorld and Six Flags Fiesta Texas theme parks, the city is visited by approximately 26 million tourists per year according to the San Antonio Convention and Visitors Bureau. The city is home to the four-time NBA champion San Antonio Spurs and the Annual San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo, one of the largest in the country.

San Antonio has a strong military presence—it is home to Fort Sam Houston, Lackland Air Force Base, Randolph Air Force Base and Brooks City-Base, with Camp Bullis and Camp Stanley outside the city. San Antonio is also home to five Fortune 500 companies and to the South Texas Medical Center, the only medical research and care provider in the South Texas region.

TRANSPORTATION

SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT



San Antonio International Airport is located in Northern San Antonio, approximately eight miles (or 15 minutes) from the downtown area. Loop 410 and U.S. 281 are the two highways providing access to the main entry points. In 2008, San Antonio International Airport serviced, on average, 260 daily domestic and international departures and arrivals, serving over 8.3 million passengers. Internet service is FREE and available throughout the airport.

San Antonio International Airport offers more than 40 restaurants, gift shops, business centers, banking and more through "SA on the Fly" ... their award-winning concession program operated under contract by The City of San Antonio. This program routinely requires and supports the goods and services of the local business community.

Terminal 1 services the following airlines: Aeromexico Connect, Aeromar, AirTran, ASA, Comair, Delta, Frontier, Mexicana, Skywest, Southwest, United, US Air.

Terminal 2 services: American Airlines, Continental, and Continental Express.

Nonstop destinations to and from San Antonio International Airport include: Atlanta, Baltimore, Charlotte, Chicago (Midway), Chicago (O'Hare), Dallas (Love), Dallas (DFW), Denver, Detroit, El Paso, Harlingen, Houston (Hobby), Houston (Intercontinental), Las Vegas, Los Angeles, Memphis, Mexico City, Minneapolis, Nashville, New York (Newark), Orlando, Phoenix, Salt Lake City, San Diego, San Francisco, San Louis Potosi, Mexico, St. Louis, Tampa and Washington, DC (Dulles).

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

Taxi cabs are available at the lower level curbside, outside of baggage claim, at Terminal 1 and at the front curbside of Terminal 2, just outside baggage claim. For assistance, please contact the Airport Ground Transportation Agent wearing an airport badge. Fare to San Antonio downtown areas are approximately \$20 to \$23 (U.S.) per taxicab. Up to 4 may share a cab.



Shuttle Service

Shuttle service is provided by Airport Express, San Antonio International Airport's authorized and single shared-ride shuttle service. Shuttles depart from 7:00 AM to 1:30 AM daily to downtown hotels every 15 minutes. Passengers may purchase tickets at the airport's baggage claim area. Ticket rates are \$18.00 per person to downtown hotels or \$32.00 for a roundtrip ticket.
